

Key Messages:

- Councils CSP and Renewable Energy Goal provided the policy structure to support community energy projects.
- Most important: Valuing more than the bottom line!
 - The investment equation for this project is considered to be far greater than finances alone.
 - ► The most significant benefits are the community partnerships, local investment, the showcase model – National profiling.
- It's not a clear straightforward path!



 - Advisory panel (6 local members)
