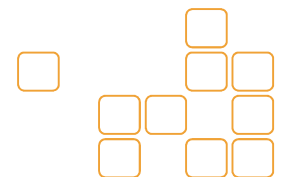
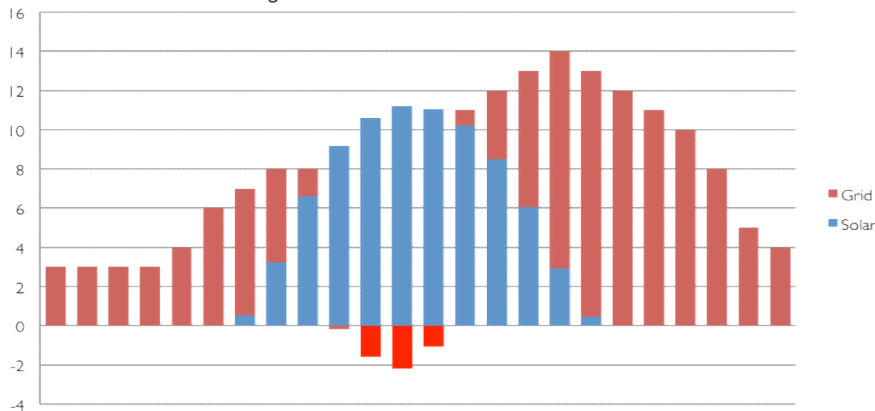


Average kW demand each hour

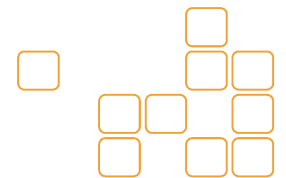


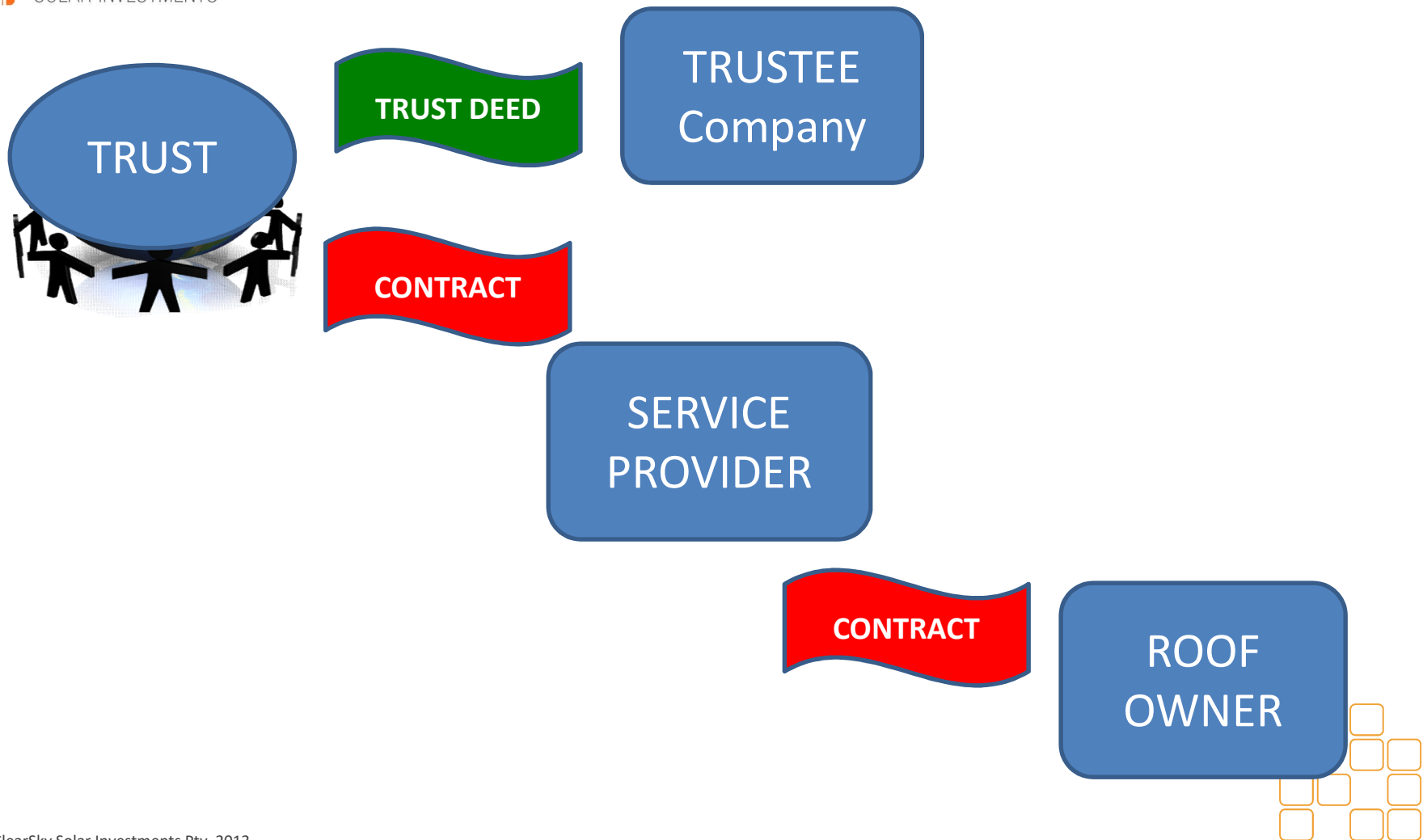

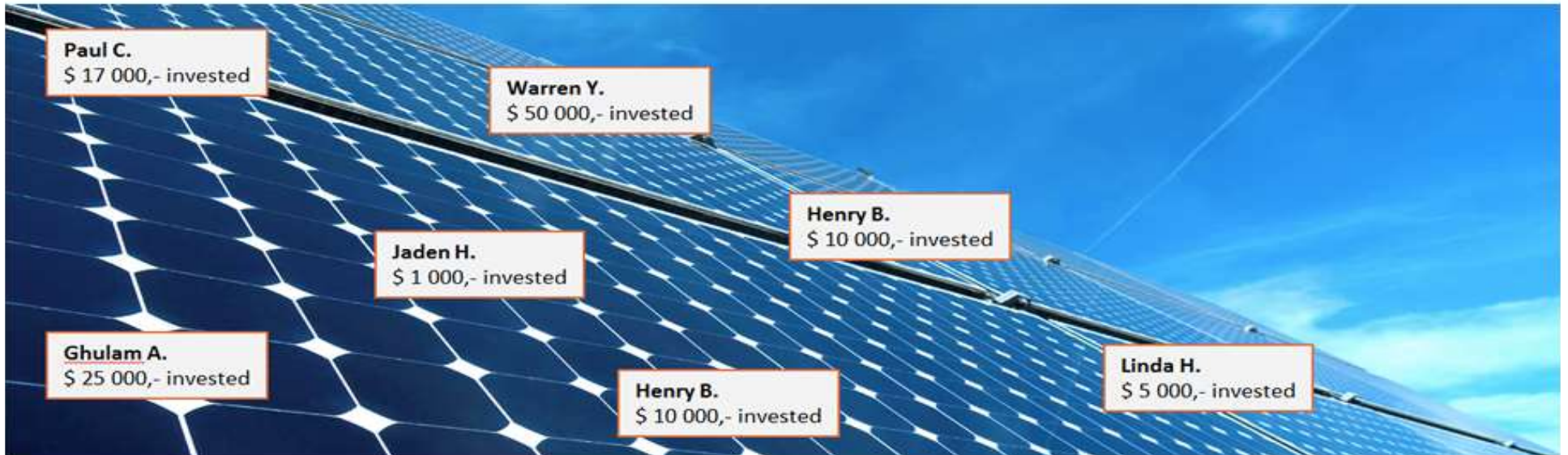
Average kW demand each hour



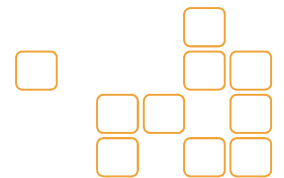

- Panels are covered by customer's insurance
- Equipment covered by warranty
- Customer has right to buy out system but on terms that maintain the investor IRR
- Ownership of panels transferred to investor if service provider goes bankrupt
- Due diligence done on customer to establish high probability that operations (possibly under new ownership) will continue without a break over next seven years
- Panels can be sold or relocated in event that customer defaults
